Spirit Week Dress-Down Days Guidelines

Class Color Monday, September 26th

Tops: Tee shirts, hoodies, sweatshirts, button-downs, and cardigans can be worn in the class color. Tops may either be mostly solid-colored, or may be a UIC College Prep pride top.

Freshman: Blue Sophomores: Red Juniors: Blue Seniors: Red

Pants: Full length solid jeans (any color), chinos (any color), or school uniform pants. They should not have holes and should not be too loose or too tight. If pants are jeggings or leggings, they are too tight! Students may choose to wear a belt. Either way, please keep those pants above the waist and underwear may not show.

Shoes: Tennis shoes, flats, or boots, keeping the usual heel rule in mind. No sandals.

Jewelry, Hair, and Makeup: Same as regular school dress code. Necklaces must be tucked beneath top.

Team Pride Tuesday, September 27th

Tops: High school, college, and professional sports teams are represented. Students may wear tee shirts, hoodies, or jerseys with a solid shirt with sleeves underneath (mandatory for basketball and cheerleading jerseys).

Pants: Full length solid jeans (any color), chinos (any color), or school uniform pants. They should not have holes and should not be too loose or too tight. If pants are jeggings or leggings, they are too tight! Students may choose to wear a belt. Either way, please keep those pants above the waist and underwear may not show. No sweatpants or joggers.

Shoes: Tennis shoes, flats, or boots, keeping the usual heel rule in mind. No sandals.

Jewelry, Hair, and Makeup: Same as regular school dress code. Necklaces must be tucked beneath top.

Wacky Wednesday, September 28th

Tops: Tee shirts, hoodies, sweatshirts, button-downs, and cardigans can be worn. If wearing a sleeveless top, a sleeved shirt must be worn underneath OR a cardigan must be worn over top.

Pants: Pants should not have holes and should not be too loose or too tight. (If they are a leggings or jeggings, they are too tight!) Skirts must reach the knee. Leggings must be layered with knee-length skirt or knee-length shorts over top.

Shoes: Tennis shoes, flats, or boots, keeping the usual heel rule in mind. No sandals. Shoes may mismatch.

Wacky Wednesday (con't), September 28th

Jewelry and Makeup: Same as regular school dress code. Necklaces must be tucked beneath top.

Hair: Spray-colored hair allowed. Color must fully rinse by Thursday. Brightly-colored wigs allowed, unless deemed too distracting by staff. No hats.

Students may not spray hair in the gym or bathrooms. Spray color must be done before entering the building.

Firecat Pride Thursday, September 29th

Tops: Shirts must be unaltered UICCP gear. Students may wear tee shirts, hoodies, or jerseys. Shirts cannot be tied in knots or ponytail holders. Athletes may wear UICCP sports jerseys so long as a solid shirt is worn underneath. No low-cut or revealing tops.

Pants: Full length solid jeans (any color), chinos (any color), or school uniform pants. They should not have holes and should not be too loose or too tight. If pants are jeggings or leggings, they are too tight! Students may choose to wear a belt. Either way, please keep those pants above the waist and underwear may not show.

Shoes: Tennis shoes, flats, or boots, keeping the usual heel rule in mind. No sandals.

Jewelry, Hair, and Makeup: Same as regular school dress code. Necklaces must be tucked beneath top.

Advisory Pride Friday, September 30th

Tops: Must not be too low-cut, tight, or revealing.

Bottoms: Must not be too tight. No tears in pants. No un-layered leggings. Skirts and shorts must reach the knee.

Shoes: Tennis shoes, flats, or boots, keeping the usual heel rule in mind. No sandals.

Jewelry, Hair, and Makeup: Same as regular school dress code. Necklaces must be tucked beneath top. No hats.
