

UIC College Prep Dance Rules and Regulations

Entry
Students must arrive no later than 1 hour after the start time, or be denied entry.
No re-entry to the building under any circumstances.
Students must have current UICCP ID and dance ticket in order to enter the dance.
NO outside guests are allowed entry to a UICCP dance.
Absolutely no refunds will be given.
The following students are NOT allowed to attend a Dance: --Students who have earned 13+ detentions --Any student currently on suspension --Any student who was absent from school the day-of --Any student who has been expelled from UICCP
Large jackets, purses, and backpacks may be inspected by the faculty chaperones before admittance.
Behavior
UICCP's code of conduct must be adhered to at all times. Students may be asked to leave the dance for inappropriate behavior of any sort. Students may earn demerits or detentions for inappropriate behavior as issued by staff.
Students should never use profanity, whether they believe it is a part of a song or not.
All dance styles must comply with standards of modesty and safety. The faculty and administrators in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of dance style. Inappropriate dancing includes, but is not limited to, the following: slam dancing, moshing, freaking or booty dancing (including prone, butt-to-crotch, crotch-to-crotch and "sandwich" dancing), or otherwise inappropriate or dangerous dancing.
Students are responsible for their own belongings at all times.
Students may bring their own camera or cell phone, however, if electronics are used inappropriately as deemed but a staff member, they will be confiscated.

Semi-Formal Attire
All UICCP Dress Code Rules Apply Unless Otherwise Stated

No Casual Clothing:

No Denim (including all pants with rivets and colored denim)

No Tee Shirts

No Sweatshirts or Hoodies

No backless, bare midriffs or sides, or sheer/see-through tops or dresses.

No cut-outs around midriff or chest. No keyhole cutouts.

No Strapless Dresses/Tops.

No Straps that are less than 1-inch thick.

Dresses or skirts must meet 2 inches above the knee. In the case that a dress or skirt is deemed too short, students may be able to enter the dance if they can attain solid (non-transparent) leggings.

No excessively low cut dresses or tops.

No excessively tight dresses or skirts.

Slits no higher than knee area.

No garters or exposed undergarments.

Dress clothes may NOT be removed to reveal undershirts or other undergarments.

Hats cannot be worn at any time during the dance.

Gentlemen may not wear earrings. Women may not wear gauged earrings or more than 1 pair.

No visible tattoos.

Regular hair and makeup rules apply.
